## Equality and Diversity *made fun!*

World Jungle's Global Play Training is designed for **teaching staff, childcare, youth and play workers** who want to help children and young people to have the opportunity to **explore cultural diversity** in fun and exciting ways. It aims to support schools, youth groups and childcare settings to effectively **meet the diverse needs of children**, promoting **positive attitudes to diversity** and the differences between each of us. It also aims to equip participants with the skills to **prevent discrimination** and **challenge prejudice**.

*One of the fundamental 'British values' is an acceptance that other people having different faiths or beliefs to oneself (or having none) should be accepted and tolerated, and should not be the cause of prejudicial or discriminatory behaviour.*

### The training programme includes:

- Exploring cultural diversity within a school, childcare, play or youth group setting.
- Why it is important for children and young people to learn about other cultures.
- Sharing ideas and promoting best practice.
- Exploring some of the common mistakes when trying to promote cultural diversity.
- Providing fresh and creative ways to promote diversity and effectively challenge discriminatory behaviour in an age appropriate way.
- Sharing traditional games, music and dance from around the world.
- Developing an Action Plan for your setting.
- Introducing World Jungle's Global Play Toolkit.



### By the end of the training...

- Participants will have a greater understanding of issues around cultural diversity, inclusion and prejudice, together with why it is so important for children to learn about different cultures.
- They will have learnt a variety of creative and age-appropriate ways to promote cultural

diversity and challenge discriminatory behaviour in their setting.

- Participants will have learnt some of the best traditional games from around the world including Ghana, Jamaica, Tanzania, Guyana, Argentina, Pakistan and England.
- They will have the tools to develop an Action Plan for their setting to ensure that activities and positive behaviours can be sustained.


